- 3. Ideas for the use of club's monies wisely to increase membership and attract new leaders and help promote outdoor activities in South Jersey were discussed. A number of good ideas were presented.
 - a. Give donations to local outdoor trusts, such as Pinelands Preservation Alliance, Delaware-Raritan Greenway, etc.
 - b. Sponsor an environmental scholarship at a local college such as Stockton State. Joe Money volunteered to follow up.
 - c. Run club activities that might not break even like a New York bus trip and use treasury money if necessary to subsidize it.
 - d. Have a wilderness first aid course for leaders, paid for by the club. We think Kathleen Pearce is qualified to teach. Bruce will reach out to Kathleen.
 - e. Offer trail maintenance stipends (e.g. gas money) to those who come out and help.
 - f. Sponsor a trail bridge along the Batona Trail or other trails

that might need a bridge. Have a "Sponsored by Outdoor Club of South Jersey" sign made for it. Bruce will reach out to the Wharton and Bass River state forest superintendents.

- g. Web service consultant to enhance club web sites.
- h. Holiday party revamp contribute club money to enhance it.
- i. More catered activities like picnics.
